CG FOUNDATION EDUCATION GRANT APPLICATION (CGFEG)

CG Foundation Grant Program: The CGFEG program is designed to assist eligible personnel in their academic or technical development by providing funding for tuition, fees, and miscellaneous expenses incurred in completing off-duty voluntary education. The CGFEG program is a reimbursement program, requiring members to expend funds prior to applying for a CGFEG. The CGFEG program is supported by gift funds from the CG Foundation. Grants will be disbursed based on availability of funds.

Eligibility: Programs are open to active duty enlisted personnel in pay grades E-3 to E-6. Reservists on any type of active duty orders of at least 180 days in duration, in pay grades E-3 to E-6, are also eligible. These grants may be used for required educational items not funded through other educational resources. The maximum payable is \$500.00, per member, per calendar year. Applications will only be accepted following the official ALCOAST announcement that funds are available. All applications received will be processed on a first come, first served basis. Copies of receipts cannot be more than 12 months old.
