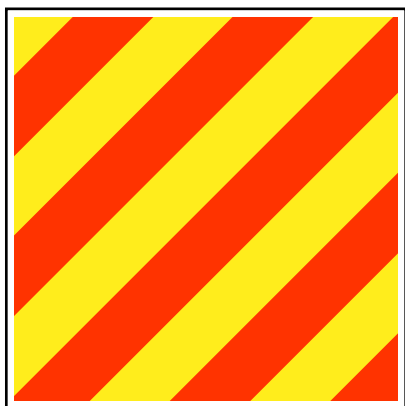

## Birthplace of the Coast Guard Enlisted Corps



**Training Center Cape May (TCCM)** is the birthplace of the Coast Guard's enlisted corps, where more than 80 percent of the service's workforce begin their career. We consider Cape May County to be the "Coast Guard's Hometown" as we provide the Coast Guard with its most important resource — **its people**.

TCCM has the potential to graduate up to 4,200 new recruits annually. Approximately 43 weeks per year, TCCM starts a new company within our eight (8) week training program. We also may have up to 800 recruits on base at any given time. We recently made Coast Guard history, graduating our inaugural 10-week beta company, November—203. The base has approximately 450 acres with 258 buildings attached. In addition to training, the base provides support for 14 tenant commands, which includes operational and support units.

**Mission:** Transforming the recruits of today into Coast Guardsmen of tomorrow while providing superior mission support.

**Vision:** To maximize and blend innovation and strategic goals to grow the Commandant's vision of a Ready Workforce 2030 and develop the next generation of Coast Guard personnel ready to lead the world's best Coast Guard into the next century while increasing retention.
