DIRECTIONS TO COAST GUARD TRAINING CENTER:

Take I-64 to Exit 250B (Ft. Eustis Blvd/Rt. 105). Go toward YORKTOWN on Rt. 105, approximately 3 ³/₄ miles to traffic light at Rt. 17. Go LEFT onto Rt. 17 NORTH. Proceed about ³/₄ mile to second traffic light and turn RIGHT onto Cook Rd. Proceed approximately 2 ¹/₂ miles to the STOP sign and turn RIGHT onto Ballard St. (Rt. 238 East). Follow this road approximately 1¹/₄ miles to the Coast Guard Training Center gate.

From points North via Rt. 17:

Follow Route 17 South across the Coleman Memorial Bridge. Proceed approximately ½ mile past bridge and turn left at traffic light onto Route 238 EAST. Follow Rt. 238 East for approximately 2 miles to Coast Guard Training Center gate.
