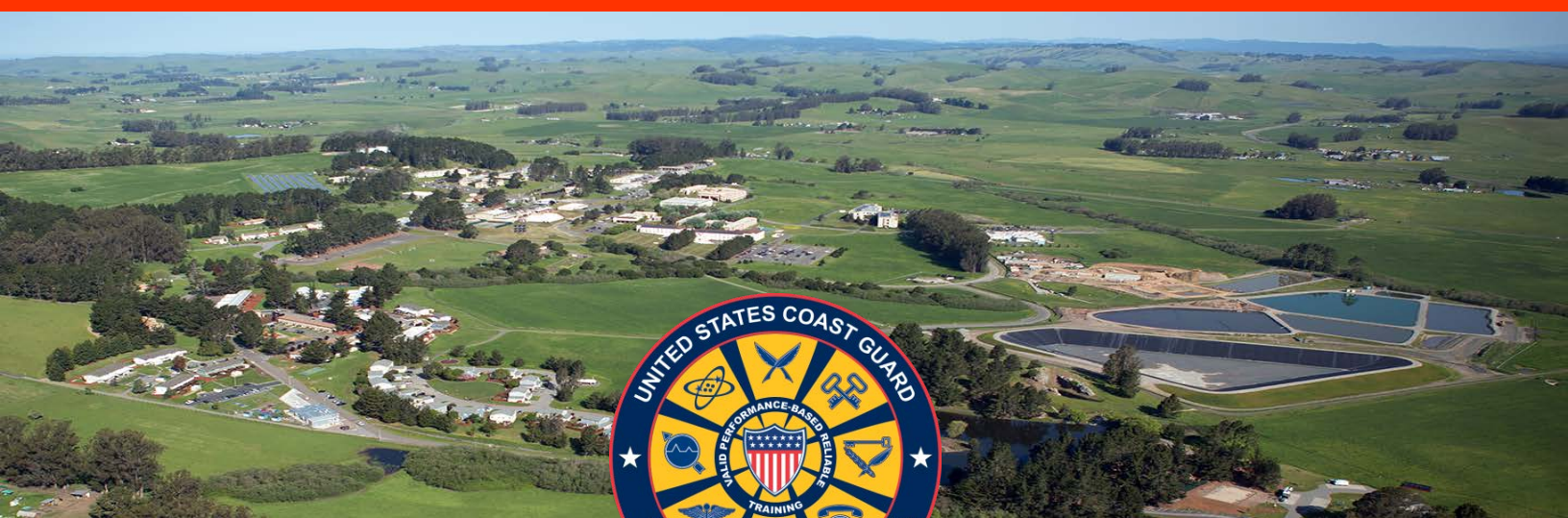

Our People

Our greatest strength and competitive advantage is the broad range of experiences and skills brought to bear by our staff of over 500 people, including 325 Active Duty, 153 Civilians (75 NAF) and 70 full-time contractors.

Our Services

Much more than training, we provide a wide-range of valuable services to the fleet:

- **Assessment.** Our Culinary Service and Finance & Administration Assessment Teams evaluate and provide units with valuable feedback to support their missions.
- **Base Support.** We support 13 units through our housing, barracks, clinic, SPO/admin and 16 MWR businesses; while our Fire Department annually responds to hundreds of emergencies onboard and in the local community.
- **Analysis.** We conduct front-end analyses to identify solutions to solve human performance problems.
- **E-Learning.** We develop e-learning solutions for the Training Center and also enterprise-wide applications.
- **Advancement Tests.** We help prepare and assess enlisted members for advancement, developing & maintaining the **Enlisted Professional Military Education** program and **Servicewide Examinations** for 7 enlisted ratings.
- **Rating Homeport.** As the knowledge center for 7 enlisted ratings, we collect, develop and maintain on-demand rating performance support & resources for E-5 to E-9.
- **Culinary Support.** As the culinary center of excellence, we support a wide range of events for local units.
- **Conference Support.** With over 300 lodging rooms, ample meeting facilities, superb location & numerous amenities, we provide a popular & cost-effective option for dozens of conferences, workshops and off-sites each year.

We are one of the Coast Guard's largest facilities with over 826,000 square feet of buildings on 830 acres, located in beautiful Sonoma County, CA. A service leader in environmental stewardship, we proudly produce 18.5% of our power through on-base solar arrays; recycle 100% of our water consumption; and reduce land management costs through an agricultural lease program covering 40% of our acreage.
